### **Delivering Sustainable Lifestyles**

For 15 years, long before carbon foot-printing was part of the vocabulary, Global Action Plan has been helping people to live more sustainably. This presentation will summarise what has been learnt during this period. It will outline the key elements that Global Action Plan believes need to be in place for a successful behaviour change programme, it will describe the role partner organizations can play in the process and it will assess the policy framework that needs to be in place to promote sustainable lifestyle.

It will include research results from UEA who have undertaken qualitative research with households participating in Global Action Plan's programmes and the impact of a project run with 1,000 households in partnership with the Women's Institute.
